

WHAT YOUR CHILD'S LOTTERY NUMBER MEANS

7th Grade

1 through 50 then you're child is a winner. Congratulations, welcome to Monte del Sol !

51 to 60 may get in but the first 50 need to decide if they want to attend Monte or not. We give winners time to decide while they observe and shadow or visit other schools, etc.

61 to 65 have a chance, but probably won't know until May or even August.

65 to 75 have an outside chance if a lot of people decline or change their minds.

75 through 300 sorry, not a winner.

SHADOWING will take place on Wednesday mornings beginning March 24. Arrange with Carly. Shadowing on March 24 and 31 is for students needing to decide between several schools and their decision must be made within a week of shadowing. Siblings of current students, and those who know for sure that they want to come here, can shadow in late April or early May. (Shadowing and observing will *not* take place during standardized testing in April.)

PARENT OBSERVATION can happen any day, arrange time with Carly after Spring Break.

8th, 9th, 10th and 11th Grade

Most of our current students move up to the next grade, so there are only openings if someone leaves Monte del Sol. (Please read *Lottery Guidelines* on the Admissions page for a fuller explanation).

12th Grade

There will be openings in 12th Grade. Please refer to the 12th grade paragraph in *Lottery Guidelines* for full details regarding state high school credit requirements for graduation. Monte del Sol requires a minimum of 27 credits to graduate.
